Application and Student Participation Agreement

The following conditions apply to all students in the International Education Program.

The student is expected to:

1. reside in a homestay that is approved and arranged by the Homestay Supervisor.
2. attend school on a regular basis. Any absences must be explained by a note to the school from the homestay parent.
3. respect and obey his/her guardian (who is the Homestay Supervisor), teachers and the homestay parents.
4. accept his/her responsibility as a student. This includes making a determined effort to succeed in his/her school work, and completing all homework and assignments on time.
5. maintain at least a 60% average and have good work habits in order to be allowed to continue in the program.
6. respect the members of the homestay family and act as a member of the family. The student will obey family rules and voluntarily assist with regular household chores. The student will not talk about the homestay family's private affairs to others.
7. share school work, report cards and other correspondence from the school with the homestay family.

The student is not permitted to:

8. visit establishments such as pornographic shops, adult theaters, bars and night clubs.
9. abuse the use of the Internet by visiting pornographic or violent sites.

Students are asked to note the following:

10. International phone calls require homestay approval. Payments for any phone calls that are made must be paid to the homestay family immediately. Students are not to run up large phone bills. A phone card is recommended.
11. By Ontario law, persons under 19 years of age are not permitted to purchase cigarettes. Smoking is not permitted on school property or public buildings. Please note - many Canadian families do not permit smoking in their home.
12. Students cannot change homestay families or schools without approval. Any changes in a homestay must be done through the Homestay Supervisor. One month's notice must be given or the homestay paid one month's fee in lieu of notice prior to any move. A \$200.00 administrative fee may also apply.
13. Students less than 18 years of age are not permitted to go on trips by themselves. A trip with the homestay family is allowed. If permission from the parents is provided in advance, a trip with another adult person is permitted. If students are going on a trip with an adult, the Homestay Supervisor and the homestay parent(s) must be informed in writing, of the destination, length of the trip and the adult supervisor's name.
14. Students less than 18 years of age are permitted to visit relatives, close family friends and other students provided that there will be adult (age 25 or older) supervision and adequate notice is given to the homestay parent. These visits should be on an occasional nature and homestay parents should contact parties involved to make sure there is no inconvenience to the hosting family.
15. Students over 18 years of age are asked to provide approval from their parents to the homestay parents prior to taking long or overnight trips and to provide the homestay parents in writing with information on how they can be contacted during the trip.

Any on-going failure to abide by the above guidelines will result in dismissal from the International Student Program and termination of the student's study permit.
