The purpose of the second public meeting is to consider continued imposition of education development charges as set out in Section 257.63 of the *Education Act*, and to inform the public generally about the education development charge proposal. Any person who attends the meeting may make a representation to the Board in respect of the proposal. The Board will also consider any written submissions. All submissions received in writing and those expressed at the public meeting will be considered prior to the enactment of an education development charge by-law. The Board will consider adoption of a by-law imposing education development charges in the City of Kingston on October 9, 2007.

The education development charge background study required under Section 257.61 of the Act (including the proposed EDC by-law) and setting out the Board's education development charge proposal will be available on or after September 4, 2007 at the Board's administrative offices, during regular office hours.

All interested parties are invited to attend the public meetings.
