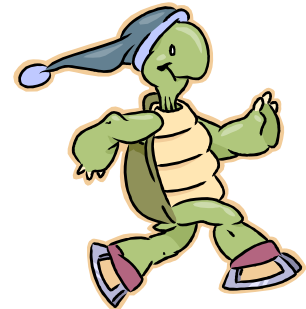

Public Skating Rules of Conduct:

All patrons who participate in ice skating programs must respect the following rules:

HELMETS ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED FOR EVERYONE ON THE ICE

- * Skate in the same direction as the other skaters
- * No horseplay / games / tag / etc.
- * No skating backwards or figure skating skills
- * No speed skating
- * No balls, pucks, chairs, pylons, or hockey sticks are to be used while skating
- * No headsets, cell phones, or hand held electronic devices are to be used while skating
- * No carrying of children is permitted
- * No strollers, wagons, toboggans, etc. are permitted on the ice
- * No sitting or climbing over the boards
