

## ASSIGNMENT INSTRUCTIONS



Your assignment is to make your own movie trailer, using the Windows Movie Maker program. Be sure to experiment with this program before you begin creating your project.

Your movie trailer must meet the following criteria:

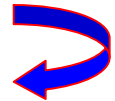
- ★ Advertise a movie of a specific genre, e.g. comedy, romance, action, etc.
  - You may make up your own movie with an original title, actors, etc. OR
  - Create a movie trailer for a movie that already exists
- ★ Be 1.5 minutes long (minimum)
- ★ Use the movie trailer components that you have studied

When you have finished your trailer, be sure to have a classmate and teacher view it for approval. Then, follow these **steps** to publish your trailer, allowing you to present it in class:

1. Click File, click Publish Movie.
2. Click This computer, and then click Next.
3. In the File name box, type the name for your movie in this format: **Last Name\_Trailer**.
4. In the Publish to box, choose where you want to save your movie once it's published, and then click Next.
5. Choose the settings you want to use to publish your movie, and then click Publish.



The .wmv file can then be moved onto a memory stick. It is important that you move the **.wmv file** and not the movie maker file. The movie maker file has nothing on it and won't work.
